



Fundraising is always a challenge. The Building committee came up with a plan that will help build the concession stand and continue to help build the Sports Complex. The bricks are an affordable way that soccer families can honor and immortalize their loved ones, soccer players, families and coaches. The majority of the brick donations go to the concession stand and continue to advance improvements at the Arnie Wolff Sports Complex after the concession building is built.

The Concession Stand

After several plans were considered, the winner is the building that will resemble the East High School concession stand. When building a concession stand, a very important consideration was the cost of the plans. We were able to get these plans at a very reduced cost, free. This enables us to put more of the funds we have towards the building.

The plans were free, however, we had to adapt the building to our site and it's usability for our clubs and the parks department requirements. Our project manager, Katrine Wygle, and former Strikers President, Joe Westberg, worked with the architect to get the needs of the AWSCAT building committee accomplished.

After months of searching and investigating plans, the building can now move to the materials and services acquisition phase. Construction phase starts spring of 2012, with completion in June.


