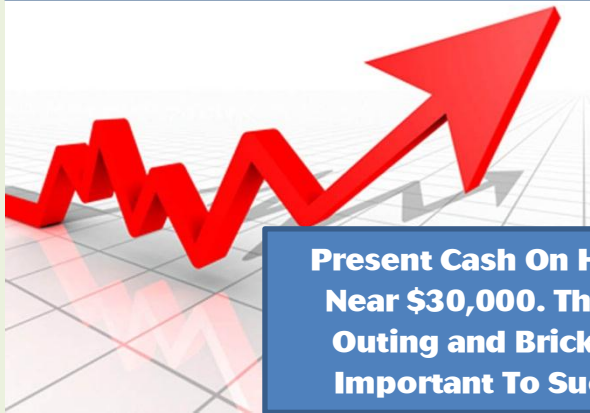
## With Good Weather We Should Be On Schedule

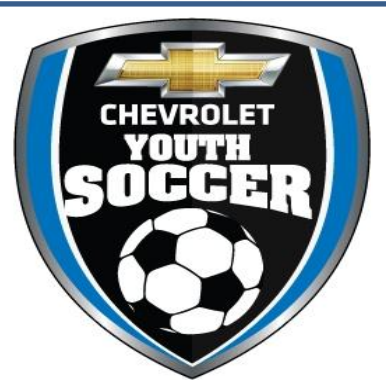

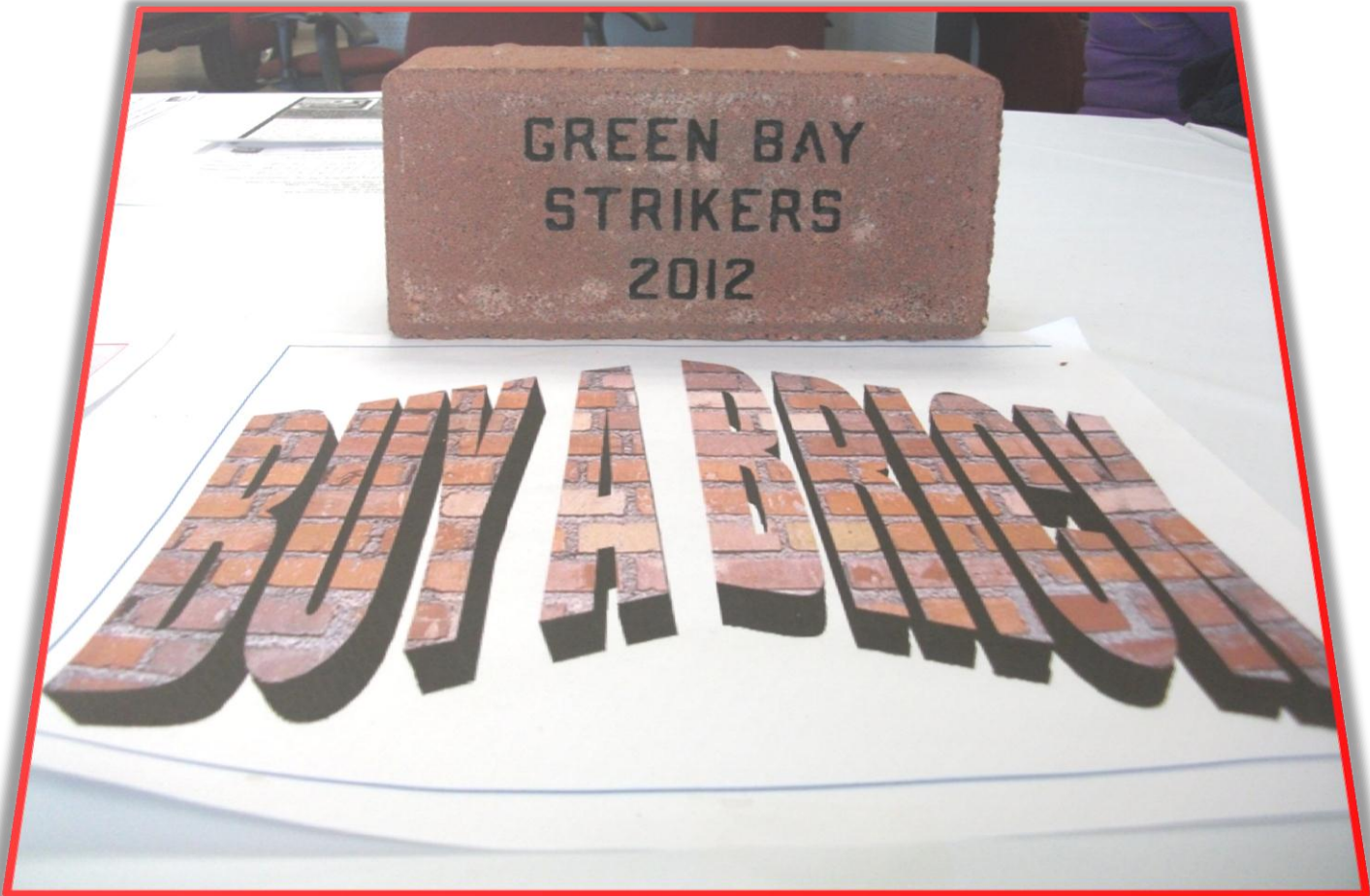

This last month our building committee met twice with the parks department involved. We discussed the colors of the building and the progress of the building plan with the architect. The plans have been adapted to fit the needs of the soccer complex, the Parks Dept. and the Brown County health dept. recommendations. Katrine Wygle and Joe Westberg have been working with them to get the final draft completed. Dan Ditschet, the park planner, provided a progress report of the complex grounds. We discussed the schedule changes to the

calendar. We discussed the great work of Eric Orfield with the roof construction projections and help from Probuilders. We also discussed the great work of Kevin Moore in his organizing of several contractors for completing the foundation and flat work of the complex building and surrounding sidewalks. We also discussed the very generous gift from an anonymous Striker board member on behalf of his family.

The Parks Department planner will be working with Ken Paluch and the Green Bay Firefighters on a deluxe sign for the entrance to the park in honor of our Green Bay fallen fire fighter.

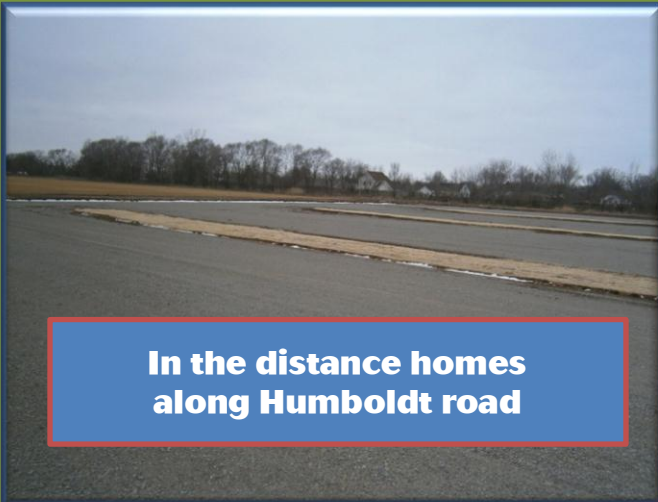
