Jacobs Construction will be forming the forms for the foundation and Peters Concrete will be supplying the concrete at a reduced cost for the benefit of the Green Bay soccer programs. Martell Construction will be laying the floor and flatwork. Scott Borkowski is the team leader for part one including the plumbing and electrical. Ken Paluch is the team leader for part II, which is the wall construction level. He will be organizing the mason team to put up the blocks. We will need a team of volunteers to assist this team. They will be wearing safety gear and will be lifting blocks and supplies for the masons. Marty Briggs is the team leader of the roof level which is part III. Probuild is providing the roof trusses at a reduced cost with Holtger Brothers providing the equipment to put the rafters in place. Pierce roofing is providing a team to install the roof sheeting and metal roofing. Scrays Doors and Laforce Doors will be the companies the doors are coming from. We have the Alex Wegner family working on the interior drywall for us.




